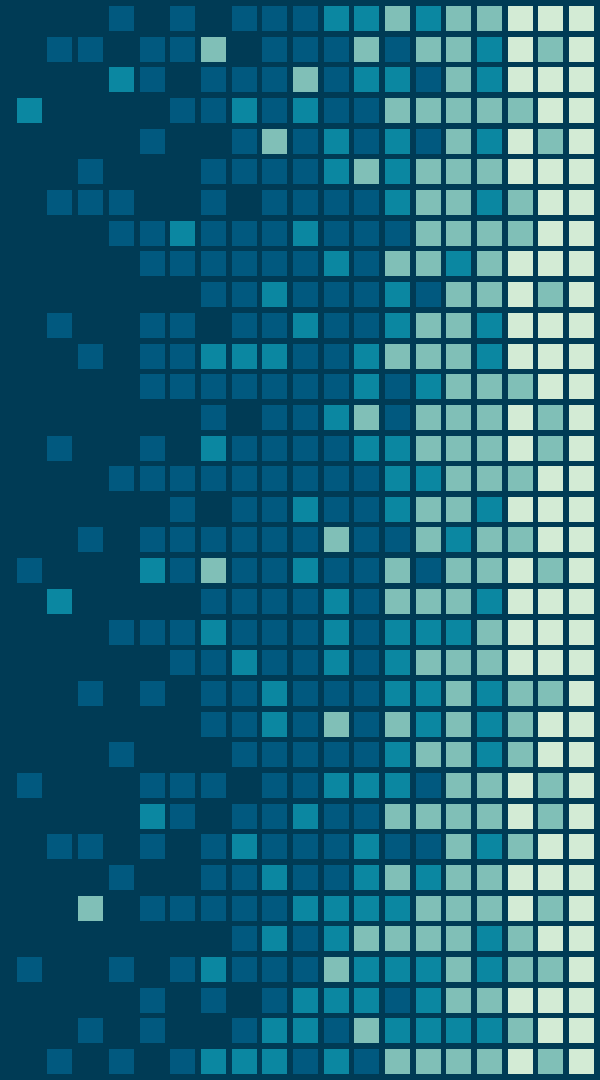


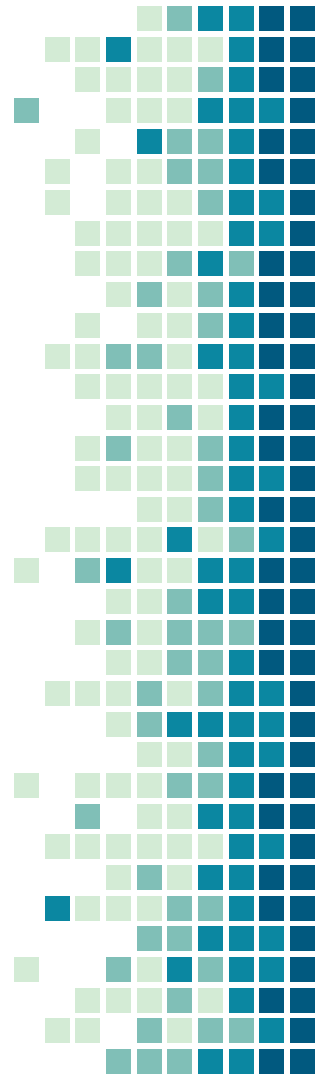

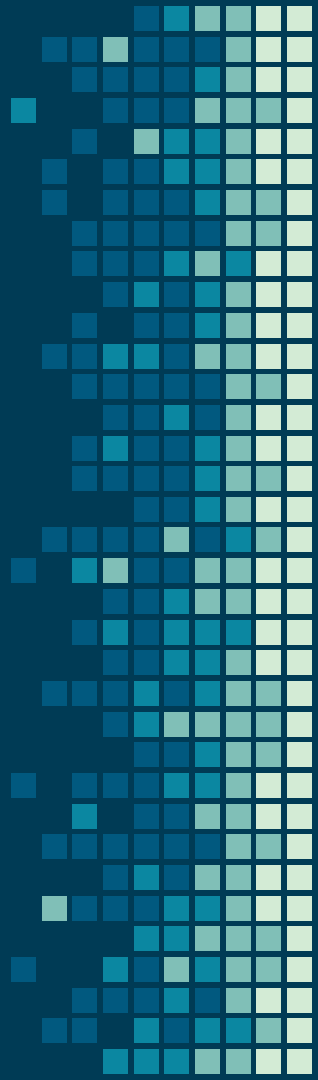

What does I.T. mean?

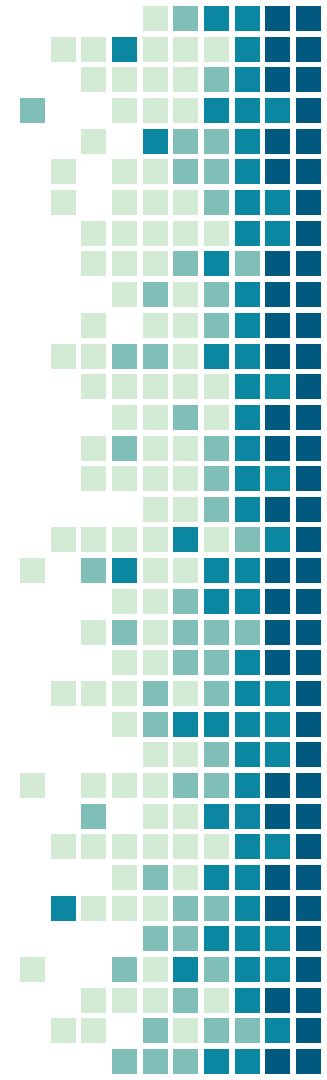


I.T. is...



Information technology (I.T.) is anything related to computing technology that includes:

- Networking – IT supports 10+ locations.
- Hardware – Servers, computers, routers, etc.
- Software – Applications for Departments
- Telecommunications - Phones, wifi, aircards
- People that work with these technologies

We can...

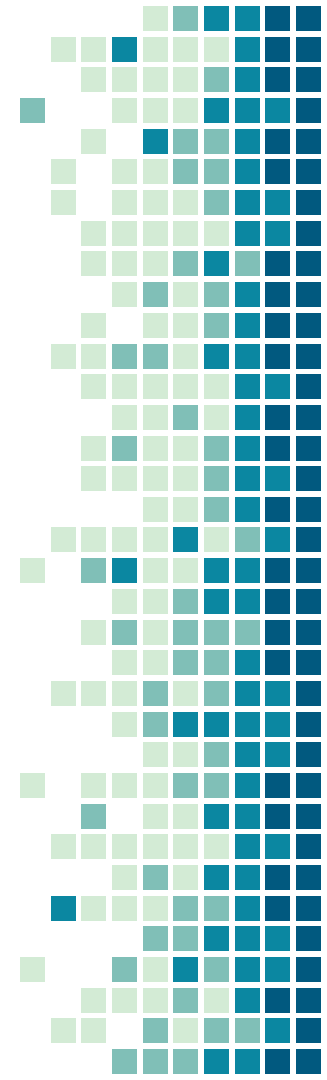
- Backup systems

- Automates processes.



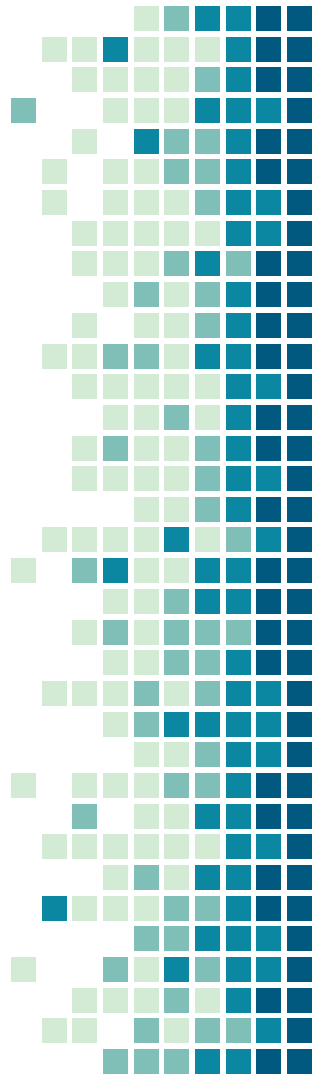


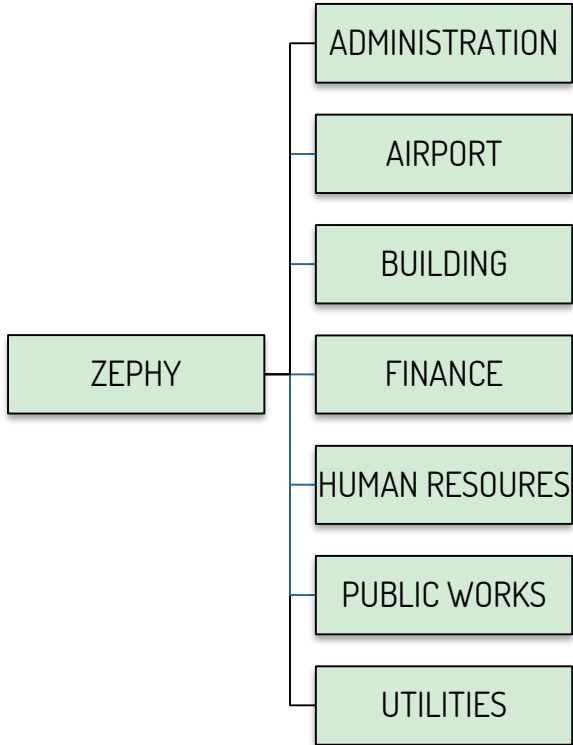
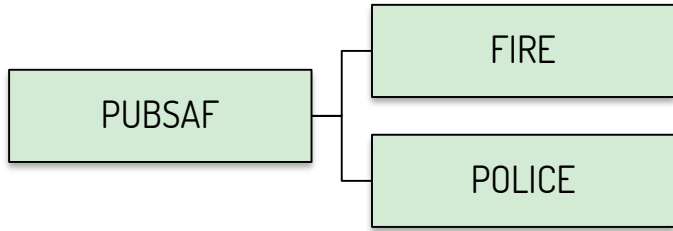
Network security

Network security



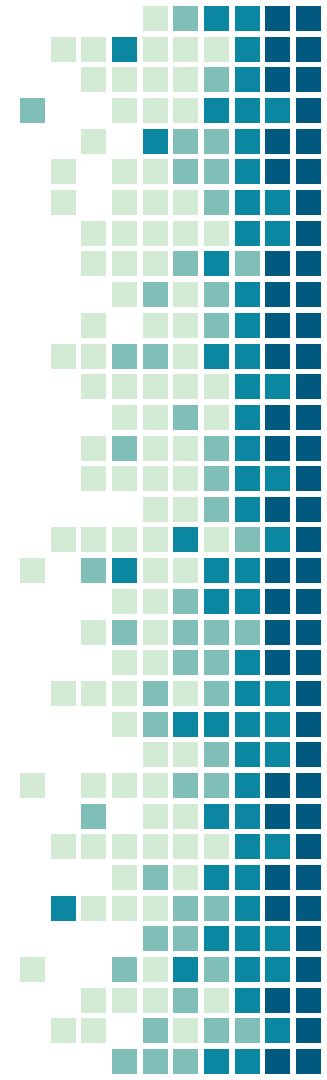
- To provide security for all connected devices, we must have a domain to govern the network
